


7) Goodbye GDP, Meet GPI

The agreement also commits to developing a genuine progress indicator, or GPI. This . . . represents a fundamental shift to a different way of measuring progress. . .


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) has been used since Simon **Kuznets** presented it to the US Congress in 1934




David Suzuki: Measuring progress with GDP is a gross mistake


